

## What's new in VRP Ver 7

### Product's data

The following elements added to product definitions:

Active – Is this an active product

Discontinued – Will not allow to re-order

Allow Discount – Is this product prohibited from getting a discount

Final Sale – A flag at the product level printed on the receipt (Moved from user defined)

Mix And Match – Moved from user defined field to a dedicated field

VIP Eligibility – Is this product allowed to participate in the VIP (Loyalty) program

Fractional – Definitions for items that can be sold as a fraction

Web Product – Flag a product to be sold also on the web

Brand

Season

Allow Layaway - Flag if the product can be on layaway

Allow Special Order - Flag if the product can be on layaway

Allow Coupon - Flag if the product can receive a discount from any coupon

Customer Required – flag if selling this product requires recording of customer's information.

Tag Design – A designated barcode tag design per product, if not entered it uses the default design.

### Efficiency

All total calculations have been moved from the application level to the database level. It means that everything runs faster and that no on hand and tally data can be wrong.

Allow to change prices and products from any satellite store.

Allow to create new items at the satellite.

Eliminate the automatic creation of palettes. Palettes are created or used only upon demand. It will also allow unlimited number of colors per product (Style)

### Gui – Graphic user interface

Complete redesign of the main screen, utilities and reports menu. Much easier to navigate and find sub programs.

Quick link option allows to group the most useful program for a group of users in one menu.

Allow to change all the product's elements from within Matrix II.
